Description:	This hands-on class is designed to help students creatively engage with history. It will follow the <i>Mystery of History Vol. 1</i> text focusing on the ancient history time period of creation through 33A.D. Students will need to read the lessons, make memory cards, and do one exercise or quiz at home each week. The exercises & quizzes will be emailed to families at the start of each week. Each student will use his/her memory cards to assemble a timeline book on a metal ring. In class, the students will have opportunities to draw timeline figures, review important & interesting facts from the lessons, do mapwork, make crafts relating to the lessons, and play review games together. Literature will be incorporated through encouragement to read historical fiction and non-fiction books relating to the time period. Children will each be encouraged to choose books that interest them and are appropriate to their own reading levels. Three book reports will be spread out and required during the course of the year. Children will have the choice of which kinds of creative book report format (skit, diarama, craft, oral report, etc.) they would like to use and share to the class.
