Description:

Early elementary literature is meant to help children fall in love with reading. To begin, students will encounter several genres of literature, ranging from nursery rhymes to historical fiction picture books, and we will spend time discussing how each story relates to us and the world around us. Next, students will gently explore antonyms, synonyms, and homophones related to the story. Also, they will lightly experience the art of the written word in the form of several literary devices, such as rhyme, repetition, similes, metaphors, idioms, and hyperboles. Children will demonstrate their understanding of stories by completing CLOZE activities (aka fill in the blank) and will occasionally make crafts about the day's reading.
