Description:	This class will continue on where Crack the Code 1 left off. The goal is to teach spelling with a systematic, multisensory, phonics approach. Students will learn rules that apply to the English language so that they will be equipped to spell and decode most words they read. Class time involves each student using a set of their own color-coded letter tiles. I will instruct class using identical letter tiles that are projected on the wall with an iPad. Students will practice spelling using real and nonsense words. Occasionally games will be played to reinforce spelling. Lessons covered : syllable division of three, four and five-syllable words, advanced schwa, vowel teams, prefixes, suffixes, doubling rule, change rule, tion vs.sion, the six rules for silent e, homophones and continuing to learn common sight words that are not able to be phonetically sounded out. Spelling and reading are intimately linked. This class should also help your child to become a better reader.
