Description

This class is a year-long study for students of all skill levels in 3rd-5th grade. The focus of the class will be on learning the foundational art elements of color, form, line, shape, space, texture, and value. Within this focus students will learn how to use different mediums including, but not limited to, acrylic and/or watercolor paints and pencil and ink. Students will also learn and increase their art vocabulary through discussion and critiquing of both professional and peer artwork. Although the class spans the duration of both the 1st and 2nd semesters, students can enroll for only the 1st or 2nd semester if they like. However, it is strongly encouraged that students enroll in both semesters in order to gain the most out of the curriculum. By the end of both semesters students will be equipped with a basic understanding of the art elements which will serve as a necessary basis for higher level art and design classes.
