Pre-Requisites: This class is recommended for 7th-8th graders. However, 6th graders with exceptionally strong writing skills or 9th graders interested in the class may also enroll. The class will adapt and use parts of an IEW-B curriculum as well as additional activities. If students have taken an IEW-A course, they should be at the level where they were able to complete most work successfully and fairly independently. If students have never taken IEW-A, they should be at the level where they are able to write basic paragraphs and generally handle basic sentence structure well and fairly independently.
