Description:

The God we serve loves celebrations but many of us are not aware of the holidays He's invited us to share. The goal of this class is to introduce the students to several of the "Feasts of the LORD" which are described for us in the Old Testament. At an age-appropriate level, a biblical explanation, including the historical significance, of the feasts will be given, as well as their connection to the New Testament and the present. The students will also learn some of the Jewish traditions associated with each feast. To culminate the academic study of each feast, the class will enjoy its own celebration, during which the students will have the opportunity to experience some traditional foods and activities. The feasts which will be introduced are: Sabbath, Passover/Unleavened Bread, Pentecost, Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, Sukkot, Purim and Hanukkah. (Note: Although the roots of Hanukkah lie in the inter-testamental period, its history is rich and the Gospel of John speaks of it.) Homework will consist mainly of crossword puzzles, matching or other light activities geared toward review and reinforcement of the lessons.
