## Identity in Christ

## Description

The purpose of this course is to teach students what it means to have our identity defined by Jesus Christ. The class will begin by considering God's original intent for humanity, how this identity was usurped at the Fall, and how Jesus restored this identity to those who put their trust in Him. Students will explore common questions such as "Who am I?", "What is my purpose?", "Why was I created?". As they dig into the truth of the scriptures, it is this instructor's hope that each one will come away from the class convinced that he/she has been "fearfully and wonderfully made," that God's plan for them is for a "future and a hope," and especially, that they will become better equipped to detect lies emanating from our culture in order to replace them with truth. The students will have the opportunity to discover some key words in the scripture's original languages in order to glean greater understanding. They may expect regular short writing assignments based on scripture and readings from the text, as well as some scripture memorization. While a 2-3 page final paper may be expected, any formal testing is unlikely. Therefore, diligent attention to assignments as well as class participation will be the bulk of their grade.
