Description

In this course students will review writing basics for sentences and paragraphs. They will learn how to plan and organize a research paper with a specific note-taking/bibliography system based on index cards. Students will write a research paper following APA guidelines with coaching. Parents will determine the length of the paper, to align with requirements established by certain diploma programs when applicable. Students will review frequent error patterns found in writing, including some grammar rules. Students will learn basic word processing skills to learn how to let the machine do the work for formatting a research paper. Students will give an oral presentation to the class about the same topic as their research papers, satisfying the public speaking requirement for high school English. When this course is completed, 3 of the 4 components of a high school English credit will be satisfied, leaving only the literature component to be satisfied outside this course.
