Description

This ancient history course follows the structure laid out by Veritas Press in their 1815 to Present Series. The time period begins in the early nineteenth century and proceeds to the present. Each history meeting will last one hour and will provide a full academic week’s worth of history. Study skills focused on will include note-taking, organization – of a notebook and of ideas, and reading for comprehension. Content covered will be modern American and world history – with the goal of helping students to become aware of significant historical events of the past ~ 100 years.
Homework Expectations:
Most weeks the students will be required to hand in the following:
- a worksheet on the material the lecture will cover
- an outline on the passage from A Child’s History of the World or a paragraph on an important personality relating to the current week’s Veritas card.
- a test on the previous week’s material
- an optional current events set of questions based on an event in the news.
In addition students will periodically hand in their notebooks and timelines, which they will add to weekly.
