## Description

Using the IEW framework (sometimes closely & sometimes more loosely), this course will equip students to understand and create the components of well-written sentences, paragraphs, essays, short research papers (MLA citation style), and a movie critique. The year will start with a brief review of the parts of speech. Then we will work through selected lessons in the textbook and a few short essays using support from outside sources. The vocabulary cards included with the textbook will be used. Students will have weekly homework assignments, and there will be occasional vocabulary quizzes at home. The year will focus on writing topics connected to world history.
